

- WELCOME -

Welcome to the Evan Thomas Institute Teaching Materials Catalog.

The Evan Thomas Institute teaching materials allow parents and teachers to create an exciting learning experience for children of all ages.

Most packets include a booklet of information on the subject, full-page illustrations that can be made into teaching materials, and facts about each illustration. Some packets include homemade books for early readers.

To make teaching materials, glue each full-page illustration onto an 11" x 11" piece of poster board (available in packs of 100 cards from the Gentle Revolution Press). On the back of the card, write or glue the name of illustration and the pertinent facts from the booklet of information. With enthusiasm, show your child each card as you say its name. Repeat 2-3 times a day for a few days. Later, begin to teach the facts about each with the same technique.

In this catalog of teaching materials, the titles are arranged in categories. Each title is followed by a short description of what is included in the packet. We have tried to make the publications suitable for a range of ages, but there are some packets especially designed for *very* early learners, and others that are quite sophisticated in comparison.

Therefore, we have marked each title with the following codes:

- * Especially suitable for newborns to very early readers.
- ** Intermediate materials—may be suitable for intermediate and sophisticated learners.
- *** Contains relatively sophisticated material.

We hope that these codes will assist you in selecting titles, and that you and your child will have plenty of fun learning together. The prices are listed separately, in alphabetical order.

- No titles may be returned or exchanged for any reason.
- Some titles may be given out at The Institutes *How To Multiply Your Baby's Intelligence Course* or *Graduate Course*.

This booklet explains the parts and workings of the digestive system. Includes 28 line drawings of the parts of the digestive system and facts about digestion.

HERBS AND SPICES**
